

Saskatchewan Genealogical Society Inc. Online 50/50 Raffle – ReROOTing SGS

Official Rules of Play:

- i. Participants must be physically present in Saskatchewan to purchase tickets.
- ii. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. If a winning ticket bears the name of a minor, the prize will be lawfully delivered on behalf of the minor to the minor's parents, legal guardian or trustee.
- iii. The purchase price of the tickets is \$10 for 1 ticket; \$20 for 3 tickets; \$50 for 10 tickets; and \$100 for 25 tickets.
- iv. The number of tickets being made available for sale will be 25,000.
- v. The deadline to purchase tickets is November 26, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. The date, time and location of the draw will be 1:30 p.m., November 26, 2024 at the Saskatchewan Genealogical Society, 110 – 1514 11th Avenue, Regina, Saskatchewan.
- vi. The draw will be conducted by a Random Number Generator and the winner announced to all participants via electronic notification or by phone.
- vii. There will be one prize drawn for.
- viii. The prize will be 50% of the gross sales to a maximum prize of \$50,000.
- ix. Conditions affecting ability to win or claim prizes, including but not limited to:
 - a. Ticket purchasers must use a valid email address to purchase tickets and claim prizes.
 - b. The prize will be delivered by Saskatchewan Genealogical Society Inc.
 - c. Members of the organization involved in the conduct and management of the raffle are prohibited from purchasing tickets.
 - d. Eligible participants can purchase tickets over the phone by calling 1-306-780-9207.
- x. Winners consent to the release of their name by the Licensee.

Unclaimed Prize:
